
Quick guide for projects below DKK 10 million

The grant approval follows a simple process of approval by the Head of Unit only. Projects below DKK 10 million are not required to be presented to the Programme Committee. The project document cannot exceed 8 pages.

Projects below DKK 10 million must reflect the overall Danish strategy for development cooperation and can maximum have one partner.
